Dress Code	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Comfortable clothing for movement <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Tee-Shirts, Leggings, Yoga Pants, and Long Shorts work well. NO SKIRTS (skorts are OK), TIGHT JEANS", "SHORT" Shorts, CROPPED TOPS, Tube Tops, or DRESS CLOTHES! Please wear close toed shoes: Sneakers, tennis shoes, gym shoes, trainers, etc. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> For Musical Theatre Camps and Classes: Dance shoes for movement/dance classes should be brought to class in a backpack or bag. NO SANDALS, NO CROCS, NO FLIP FLOPS! GET will provide one camp tee shirt that will be worn on Mondays and Fridays (although we love it when they wear their shirt every day!). Camp Materials	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> BRING EVERY DAY: LABEL IT ALL! We reserve the right to discreetly label camper clothing if lost items become an issue. Snacks -- there will be a 5-10-minute snack break between the first two classes in the morning and the last two classes in the afternoon. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Please pack snacks separately from lunches. Additional snacks/juice/water may be purchased for \$1/item. The snack commissary will be available during snack breaks and lunch. LUNCH- Please send your student with a lunch every day. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Running late and cannot pack a lunch? Purchase lunch with us for \$5 (includes Cup of Noodles, fruit, juice, and chips). Sign up and purchase at check- in. A water bottle, full and leak-proof- these are allowed in the classroom if they are filled with water.

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Pen/pencil & notebook – some of the teachers may encourage (but will not require) students to bring something to write on for some of the activities; they will let students know in advance if these are needed. • A backpack or string bag to put these things in. • Script: if students are issued a script, students should bring their scripts to camp each day.
NOT ALLOWED AT CAMP:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • NO electronics, trading cards, novels, gum, music devices, weapons, toys. • Cell Phone Policy: Cell phone usage is not permitted during camp classes. We will encourage students to engage with each other during breaks but allow them to use their devices at that time. We ask that students do not take photos or videos of people without their permission or make social media posts of people without their permission. • We have a phone check in area so that phones are not a distraction during active class time. • <i>If you need to reach your child, please call the Education Department at (770)-910-7462 and we will retrieve your child.</i>
MEDICATION	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • By law we are NOT permitted to dispense regular medication to any child.
GETTING SICK AT CAMP:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Sick campers will be separated from their group and parents will be called to pick them up if needed. • Illness and/or injury is the only reason campers may call home during camp unless there is an emergency.
BIRTHDAYS:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • If your child's birthday falls during camp, we will help them celebrate - If you bring a snack for your child's group, please get prior approval from the Education Director to be considerate of food allergies and make sure there is enough for all.

Cancellation Policy

- As per Georgia Ensemble Theatre and Conservatory's policy, all camps require a non-refundable deposit due at the time of registration. We must receive two weeks' notice of cancellation. After that, no refunds will be made on tuition and remaining balances will be run.

MORNING DROP-OFF

FIRST DAY CHECK-IN PROCEDURES FOR ALL CAMPERS

- First day check in will begin at 8:15 a.m.
- Camp will begin promptly at 9:00am
 - Start time is different for TRIPLE THREAT JUNIORS, IMPROV & SKETCH FEST and THEATRE ARTS EXPLOSION. First day check-in for these camps begins at 9:15 a.m.

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- Upon arrival you will see a G.E.T (Georgia Ensemble Theatre). Camp staffer directing you to our parking lot.
- Drop off in the theater lobby. Parents are welcome to tour the building and make sure that their children are settled. Some families choose to say goodbye in the lobby.
- At the Sign-In Table
 - Student Paperwork
 - Payment verification
- Once inside:
 - Tee Shirt
 - Lunches
 - Parent Advisory Committee (a great resource for learning how you can become more involved with our program)
- You will then be directed to the theatre where we will begin and end every day.

If you arrive later than 9:00AM (10:00AM for Triple Threat Juniors, Improv & Sketch Fest, Theatre Arts Explosion), please bring your child inside and check in with a Georgia Ensemble Theatre staff member.

DAILY CAMPER DROP-OFF PROCEDURES

- Daily check-in will begin at 8:30 a.m.
- Camp will begin promptly at 9:00 a.m.
 - 9:30 a.m. drop-off time for TRIPLE THREAT JUNIORS, IMPROV & SKETCH FEST, THEATRE ARTS EXPLOSION with a 10:00 a.m. start time
- Every morning there will be staff members with a sign-in station in the lobby or at the front of the building.
- We ask that our families are patient with the drop-off and pick-up experience.
 - Students must be dropped off between 8:30-8:55AM.
 - Any student arriving before that time will need to pay for extended day care. Extended day/morning must be reserved before the day you are using it so that appropriate staffing can be secured.
 - Triple Threat Juniors, Improv & Sketch Fest & Theatre Arts Explosion participants, please adjust to a 10:00AM drop off schedule.
- If you need to speak with camp staff, please park and walk in.

AFTERNOON PICK-UP

PICK UP:

- We will run our pick-up in the same way that we do morning drop-off.
- Students must be picked up between 4:00-4:20PM (5:00-5:20PM for Performance Camp & Design/Tech).
 - Any student here past that time will need to pay for extended day care.
- A GET Staff Member will be in the lobby to do check out. You will ask for your child, we will call for them, and they will come out
- If someone other than a parent (or designated person on the student paperwork) is picking up your child, we will need to have that in writing when the student arrives at camp that day or earlier. Please send us an email at education@get.org if someone else will be picking up your student.
- If your student drives themselves to camp, a staff member will escort them to the parking lot.
- **Extenuating circumstances** - If you have an extenuating circumstance and need to pick up your child early or otherwise deviate from the normal pick-up procedures, please let us know.
